# REGISTRATION

## FORMS

1. The **Registration Form** and the **Medical Form** must be filled out completely.  
\* Please PRINT and make sure forms are SIGNED.
2. Return completed forms to the camp coordinator at your church OR mail forms, *with the full camp fee*, to:

**NOTE:** Beginning in 2011, all registration forms must be received with **PAYMENT IN FULL**. If your church is paying a portion of the registration fee, your form needs to be sent to the church, along with your portion of the fee.

**ANY FORMS RECEIVED BY THE CAMP WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL WILL BE RETURNED, VOIDING YOUR ORIGINAL POSTMARKED DATE.**

3. Each camp is filled on a first come, first serve basis. Register early!
4. No one is barred because of race, color, gender, or creed.

## INSURANCE

The family or individual coverage of the camper is the **primary** insurance for accidents and injuries. Lakeview Christian Camp provides coinsurance for all campers. The camp insurance will pay costs not covered by the primary policy to the limits of the camp policy. **Parents must list their insurance company and policy number on the Medical Form!**

## EARLY BIRD SPECIALS

There are TWO early bird deadlines this year. This gives you an opportunity to save even more! Please see the schedule on the front of this brochure for dates & discounted rates.

## TIMES

1. **Registration at camp begins at 4:00 p.m.** for all summer camps. (Dorms *will not* be unlocked until 4:00).  
**\*\*Exception: Day Camp will begin at 10:00 a.m.\*\***
2. Drivers should allow for at least *one hour* to check in campers. Drivers are responsible for campers until registration process is completed.
3. ALL summer camps will **end at 12:00 p.m.** on the final day. **\*\*Exception: Day Camp will end at 3:00 p.m.\*\***
4. Please note the specific dates of your particular camp, as some begin and end on different days of the week.

## ALL-INCLUSIVE CAMPS

In an effort to minimize confusion and lost money, **ALL OF OUR CAMPS** are now **all inclusive!** This means that the fee for these camps will cover registration, T-shirt, and canteen money for each camper. The **ONLY** money that should be sent to camp with students should be for missions, if desired.

## DIRECTIONS

To get to Lakeview from:

- **Hwy 24**--Take Hwy 258 exit (24 miles east of Hill City/8 miles west of Stockton), go south. Camp is about 3 miles down the road (which will go over the dam and curve right).
- **Hwy 18**--Seven miles west of Plainville is Zurich. In Zurich, turn north on 10 Road (look for a brown sign that says Webster Reserve Wildlife Area). Camp is about 11 miles down the road which will curve to the right.

**Look for the Chapel on the hill and the sign over the entrance.**
